WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Henry M. Coy and Lallie M. Coy
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other valuable DOLLARS,
in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said J. H. Pantler and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: all his right,
title and interest in and to the Northwest Quarter of
the Northwest Quarter of Section thirty two (32) in Township
seventeen (17) North Range (41) East of the Oklahoma base and Meridian
in the 2nd Ter. containing 40 acres more or less according to the U.S.
Gov. Survey thereof and being the homestead of his deceased
brother Anderson Johnson
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. H. Pantler and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. H. Pantler that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lallie M. Coy, wife of the said Henry M. Coy for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. H. Pantler all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
