**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Chester V. Hamilton and  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar DOLLARS,  
and other considerations this day paid to me by Jeannette Hoover,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Jeannette Hoover and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
all of lot No. six in Block No. one in The Hodge Addition  
to the said City of Tulsa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Jeannette Hoover and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Jeannette Hoover that I will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jeannette Hoover, wife of the said Chester V. Hamilton, for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Jeannette Hoover all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
