**WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we I. J. Buck and Belle M. Buck
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Nineteen Hundred DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by Wynona Paschal the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged and confessed, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Wynona Paschal and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Western District Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
The north one-half of Lot numbered three (3), in Block numbered
fourteen (4), of the town of Tulsa Indian Territory according to the
recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Wynona Paschal and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Wynona Paschal that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Belle M. Buck, wife of the said I. J. Buck for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Wynona Paschal all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
