WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Martha L. Shackelford and a single person
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty-four Hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
in hand paid by W. D. Shackelford, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said W. D. Shackelford, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The southerly 75 feet of
Lot No. 2 in Block No. 154 in the original town of Tulsa, Indian Territory (but now the
state of Oklahoma), according to the official Plat and Survey thereof. The same having a
frontage of 75 feet on South Travis Ave., and a uniform width of seventy-five (75) feet
to the alley, and adjoining West Sixth Street.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said W. D. Shackelford and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. D. Shackelford that he will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Martha L. Shackelford, wife of the said W. D. Shackelford for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. D. Shackelford all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
