paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said Albert Reenes and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
real property and premises situate in the City of Tulsa State of Oklahoma to-wit:

lot numbered seven in Block numbered five (5), in
Brady Heights addition to the City of Tulsa as the same
appears from the recorded plat of said addition together
with all improvements thereon and appurtenances there-
unto belonging and warrant the title to same

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Albert Reenes and unto his heirs
of the second part his heirs and assigns forever free clear and
discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes and judgments
mortgages and other liens and encumbrances of whatever nature
And hereby covenant with said Albert Reenes that will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Georgia B. Tucker wife of the said William F. Tucker and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Albert Reenes all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
