OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Andrew Johnson and Eliza Johnson  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other valuable consideration <sup>DOLLARS</sup>  
in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said J. F. Pantler and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of the  
Southwest Quarter (1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (1/4) in Section Thirty-two  
(32), of Township Seventeen (17), North and Range Fourteen (14) East  
of the Indian Base and meridian in Indian Territory and containing  
Forty (40) acres more or less according to the U. S. Govt. survey  
thereof and being a portion of the allotment (exclusive of homestead)  
of the deceased her husband Andrew Johnson  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. F. Pantler and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. F. Pantler that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Eliza Johnson, wife of the said Andrew Johnson for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. F. Pantler all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
