**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we C. R. Privett and Amy Privett  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred DOLLARS,  
to her in hand paid by Henry Hornecker, the receipt of which  
is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Henry Hornecker and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Town of Sixty Indian Addition Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Lots number fifteen (15) and sixteen (16) in Block number  
Twenty five (25) according to the plat of said Indian Ad-  
dition to Sixty Indian Territory.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Henry Hornecker and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Henry Hornecker that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Amy Privett, wife of the said C. R. Privett for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Henry Hornecker <sup>my</sup> all rights of dower and homestead in and to <sup>the</sup> said lands.
