WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we S. K. Williams and Bessie L. Williams
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve $\frac{50}{100}$ DOLLARS,
to us paid by Alice Masters

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Alice Masters and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 and the west half shown on the U.S.
Survey as Lots 1 & 2 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec 31, T. 19 N. and Range 14
E. Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory
to wit: Lot 9, Block 29, as twenty nine
in Valley I.T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Alice Masters and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Alice Masters that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said S. K. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Alice Masters all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
