# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we S. K. Williams and Bessie L. Williams

to us paid by J. H. Swope

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. H. Swope and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the N. E. 1/4 of the N. W. 1/4 and the west half shown on the  
U. S. Survey as Lots 1 & 2 of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec 31 T. 19  
N. and Range 14 E. Creek Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory to wit Lot 13  
no thirteen Block 20, no twenty in Valley  
J. H. Swope

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. H. Swope and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. H. Swope that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams wife of the said S. K. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. H. Swope all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
