OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Mary D. Kreager and H. A. Kreager, her husband,
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Henry S. Davis and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
lots numbered seventeen (17) Eighteen (18) - Nineteen (19) -
and Twenty (20), in Block number Eight (8), in Burnett's
Addition to the City of Tulsa, as shown by the
"Revised Plat" thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Henry S. Davis and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Henry S. Davis that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, H. A. Kreager husband, wife of the said Mary D. Kreager for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Henry S. Davis all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
