KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we A.K. Williams and Bessie L. Williams  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve <sup>50</sup>/<sub>100</sub> DOLLARS,  
to us paid by Thos M. Mc Donalddo hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Thos M. Mc Donald and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:and the west half shown on the U.S. Survey as Lots  
142 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 3, T. 19 N and Range 14 E.  
Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian  
Territory to wit Lot 19, Mc Donald Block 19, No  
11914 in Valley I.T.TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Thos M. Mc Donald and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.And hereby covenant with said Thos M. Mc Donald that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said A.K. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of
