WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we I. Ella Thompson single person who heir at law of Mary Thompson deceased his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS, and other good & valuable considerations

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Bella Anderson and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The west 1/2 of north west 1/4 and the north east quarter of southwest quarter of section 33 Twp. 19 N. and range 11 East of the Indian Meridian being the same more or less being the allotment of Mary Thompson deceased

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Bella Anderson and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Bella Anderson that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, V L L L L, wife of the said V L L L L for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said V L L L L all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
