WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Charles Feeley ^{husband of} Oddie Owen and deceased Oddie Feeley
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred DOLLARS,
was in hand paid by Chauncey A. Owen.

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Chauncey A. Owen and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South west quarter (1/4) of Section three (3) Township
Sixteen north (16), Range thirteen (13) east

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Chauncey A. Owen and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
I contract and bind myself
And hereby covenant with said Chauncey A. Owen that I will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all ~~claims~~ persons claiming the same by and through me.

And I, Oddie Feeley, wife of the said Charles Feeley for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Chauncey A. Owen all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
