WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Frank C. Parker and Arizona Parker
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) DOLLARS,
in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Virginia Walton and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Two (2) in Block Forty-four (44) in the Town of
Palea Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Virginia Walton and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Virginia Walton that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Arizona Parker, wife of the said Frank C. Parker for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Virginia Walton all my rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
