WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

here and assigns forever, the following

District of the Indian Territory to wit: -

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Logan Moore Lumber Company, its successors
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said Logan Moore Lumber Company that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Edna M. Deeds, wife of the said Elisha D. Deeds for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Logan Moore Lumber Company
all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
