OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, C.B. Lynch and Jay Forsythe and E. J. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe their wives
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & Twenty-five ^{no. (37322)} 1200 DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Ellen Orowke and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots nine ten & eleven (9-10 & 11) Block Nineteen (19)
Lynch & Forsythes Addition to Tulsa I.T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Ellen Orowke and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant s. with said Ellen Orowke that They will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. it being agreed by Ellen Orowke in the
acceptance of this deed that there is no drilling for oil or gas on above lots

And I, we, E. J. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe ^{the wife of said C.B. Lynch and Jay Forsythe}
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ellen Orowke all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
