KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we S. H. Williams and Bessie L. Williams

to us paid by Mrs. Holden

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Mrs. Holden and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the N. 1/4 of the N. 1/4 of the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: west half  
(shown on the map survey as lots 1 & 2) of the N. 1/4 of Sec. 21, T. 19 N.  
and range 14 E, Creek Nation Western District of the Indian  
Territory, Grant.  
Lot 2 in Block 4 in the four  
in Valley S. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mrs. Holden and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mrs. Holden that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said S. H. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mrs. Holden all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
