WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we C. W. Singleton and Bessie Singleton
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred DOLLARS,
In hand paid by Mary E. Kennedy receipt of which is hereby acknow-
ledged and confessed. do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Mary E. Kennedy and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Five (5) in Block Two (2) in George Douglass Addition
in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma according to the recorded
plat thereon.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mary E. Kennedy and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary E. Kennedy that she will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie Singleton, wife of the said C. W. Singleton for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mary E. Kennedy all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
