**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we S. D. Logsdon and Ellen Logsdon  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy hundred & Fifty DOLLARS,  
in hand Paid

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said R. B. Finnell and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Tulsa County State of Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

W 1/2 of NW 1/4 of N 3/4 & NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of N 3/4 of Sec. 13 T. 20 R. 13 E.  
Being in all thirty acres more or less as the case  
may be.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said R. B. Finnell and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. B. Finnell that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ellen Logsdon, wife of the said S. D. Logsdon for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. B. Finnell all rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
