WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we W. E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$1600.00 DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by William Guthrie the receipt
whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said William Guthrie and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered Three (3) in block numbered four (4) in the
George Perryman Addition to the City of Tulsa according
to the official plat thereon.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said William Guthrie and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
I contract and bind myself
And hereby covenant with said William Guthrie that I will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. persons claiming the same and through me. Subject
however to two mortgages aggregating \$600.00

And I, Emily M. Campbell, wife of the said W. E. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said William Guthrie my all rights of dower and homestead in and to said the lands.
