# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. D. Hagler and Margaret Hagler  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by A. Brown the receipt whereof  
is hereby confessed and acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said A. Brown and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
Lots numbered five and six in Block numbered three  
in the Bliss addition to Tulsa according to the recorded  
plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said A. Brown and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said A. Brown that they will forever warrant and defend  
the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Margaret Hagler, wife of the said J. D. Hagler for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. Brown all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
