OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. L. Hutcherson and Malissa Hutcherson  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Ninety-four DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by George + Sallie Clifton, receipt  
of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said George + Sallie Clifton and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the town of Owasso Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The undivided one-half interest in and to the north  
Eighteen (18) by Twenty-five (25) feet of lot number Four (4)  
in block number Fifteen (15), facing 16 feet on Kansas  
Street in the incorporated town of Owasso, A.T.  
according to the U. S. Government survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said George + Sallie Clifton and unto their heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George + Sallie Clifton that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Malissa Hutcherson, wife of the said J. L. Hutcherson for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said George + Sallie Clifton all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
