**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we C. D. Harlow and Susan Harlow  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One <sup>no</sup> 100 DOLLARS,  
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and paid by  
J. I. Harlow do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. I. Harlow and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 51 Block (50) Right according to the Official  
Plat of City of Tulsa Ind. Ter.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. I. Harlow and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. I. Harlow that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Susan Harlow, wife of the said C. D. Harlow for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. I. Harlow my all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
