WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. A. Friend and Julia A. Friend  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred \$800.00 DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by Rudolph C. Rebholz the  
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Rudolph C. Rebholz and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Friend addition to the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot 6 in Block 6 as shown by the recorded  
plat of the Friend addition to the City of Tulsa  
Land Co.,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Rudolph C. Rebholz and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Rudolph C. Rebholz that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Julia A. Friend wife of the said J. A. Friend for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Rudolph C. Rebholz all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
