# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Jay Foreythe and Jennie Foreythe  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred (\$800.00) DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full  
do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. M. Foreythe and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots Twelve & Thirteen (12 & 13), Block Fifteen (15)  
Quack & Foreythe's Addition to Tulsa Ind. Terr.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. M. Foreythe and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S. with said J. M. Foreythe that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Jennie Foreythe, wife of the said Jay Foreythe for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. M. Foreythe all rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
