OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. D. Hagler and Margaret Hagler
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Eight Hundred DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by Laura M. Harrison, the receipt
whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Laura M. Harrison and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots numbered One, Two, Eleven and Twelve in
Block numbered One in Block Addition to Tulsa
according to the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Laura M. Harrison and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Laura M. Harrison that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Margaret Hagler, wife of the said J. D. Hagler for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Laura M. Harrison all rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
