WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell, his wife and W. P. Moore and Anna E. Moore
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Fifty 00 DOLLARS,
twice in hand paid by Mattie J. Fox, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged. do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Mattie J. Fox and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Moose Addition West Tulsa Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lots numbered Eleven (11) and Twelve (12), in Block
Number Four (4), situated in Moose Addition to West Tulsa
Creek Nation Indian Territory, according to the recorded
plat filed thereby.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Mattie J. Fox and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mattie J. Fox that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell and Anna E. Moore wives of the said John O. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mattie J. Fox all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
