OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said D. D. Reber and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Ally Lot numbered Twenty-two in Block numbered
Nineteen situated in the Town of West Tulsa Creek Nation
Indian Territory according to the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said D. D. Reber and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said D. D. Reber that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell wife of the said John O. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said D. D. Reber my all rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
