KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of *Three Hundred & Twenty Five* ^{DOLLARS} *75 Dollars* The receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged in hand paid by *Margaret M. Dulyre* do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said *Margaret M. Dulyre* and unto *her* heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the *Lindsey Second Addition to* ^{Chas. & D.} Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
The town lot numbered nine (9) Block numbered nine (9)
as per Plat thereof made by J. L. Patton.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said *Margaret M. Dulyre* and unto *her* heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *Margaret M. Dulyre* that *they* will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, *J. W. Lindsey husband* of the said *Lila D. Lindsey* for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *Margaret M. Dulyre* all right of ~~dower~~ ^{my curtesy} and homestead in and to said lands.
