WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Maurice A. De Vinna and Etta M. De Vinna
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred fifty DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said the Gentry Hancock and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 4 four in Block 3 three in Brady Heights
Addition to City of Tulsa I.T. according to Plat-
made by J. H. Patton

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Gentry Hancock and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Gentry Hancock that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Etta M. De Vinna wife of the said Maurice A. De Vinna for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Gentry Hancock all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
