OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we W. M. Gibson and Bertha B. Gibson
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
to them paid cash on hand, the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged, as paid from Nova Yergain of Skiatook, Ind. Ter.
bargain, sell and convey unto said Nova Yergain and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Sehoke Nation, Northern Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all and severally of lots number thirteen (13) and fourteen, (14)
in block thirty-eight (38), all situated within the town of
Skiatook, according to the survey and recorded plat thereof,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Nova Yergain and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Nova Yergain that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bertha B. Gibson, wife of the said W. M. Gibson for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Nova Yergain all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
