OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Mary Turley and James W. Turley her husband
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,
now in hand paid by A. R. Lewis, the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said A. R. Lewis and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots ten (10) eleven (11) twelve (12) Thirteen (13) and
fourteen (14) in block One (1) of the Turley addition
to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory, according to
recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said A. R. Lewis and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said A. R. Lewis that she will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, /, wife of the said / for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said / all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
