WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we I, Frank C. Giddings and unmarried
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred (\$200.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid by Lilly A. Cantrell

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Lilly A. Cantrell and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot 8 in Block 100 (2) of the lands addition to Tulsa
I.T. according to the plat thereof filed and of Record in the office
of Recorder for the 28th Recording District

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Lilly A. Cantrell and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Lilly A. Cantrell that I will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

All gas and oil rights are reserved. But no drilling for either oil or gas shall be done on the
above described property without the consent of the party, the grantee herein named
And I, wife of the said for and in consideration of the said sum of

money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lilly A. Cantrell all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
