do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said T. J. Funk and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the west half of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 31, T. 19 N., R. 14 E., Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
