WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. A. Friend and Julia A. Friend
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Emma Malcolm, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Emma Malcolm and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lot five (5) Block six (6) according to the survey
and approved plat of Friend Addition to the
City of Tulsa Creek Nation Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Emma Malcolm and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Emma Malcolm that They will forever warrant and defend
the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Julia A. Friend wife of the said J. A. Friend for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Emma Malcolm all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
