**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. W. Clark and Anna B. Clark  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty <sup>no</sup> 00 DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid by J. B. Clark, the receipt of which is  
hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. B. Clark and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: a plat of ground  
beginning at a point on the quarter section line three hundred and  
sixty feet east of the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of the  
north west quarter of section seven of township nineteen (19) north range  
thirteen (13) east thence running east one hundred and eighty feet thence  
running north three hundred feet thence running west one hundred  
and eighty feet thence running south three hundred feet to place of begin-  
ning, being a part of the south east quarter of the north west quarter of  
section 7 of township 19 north, range thirteen (13) east.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. B. Clark and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant: with said J. B. Clark that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Anna B. Clark, wife of the said J. W. Clark for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. B. Clark all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
