KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we S. K. Williams and Bessie L. Williams, his wife  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve 50-100 DOLLARS,  
to be paid by Jennie Wright.

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto the Jennie Wright and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the

NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the west half (shown on the U.S. survey  
as lots 14 & 2) of the NW 1/4 of sec. 31 T. 19 N. & Range 14 E  
Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory, Cont.  
Lot 16 no sixteen Block 2 no twenty in Valley, Ind.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Jennie Wright and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Jennie Wright that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said S. K. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Jennie Wright my all rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
