**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we George West and Lizzie West  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five DOLLARS,  
now in hand paid by W. H. Barksdale, the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged. do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said W. H. Barksdale and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot seven (7) in Block four (4) in Turley's Addition to the City  
of Tulsa by the plat of said addition filed for record at  
Sapulpa in the eight recording district.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said W. H. Barksdale and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. H. Barksdale that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lizzie West, wife of the said George West for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. H. Barksdale all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
