WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty five DOLLARS,
The receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Belle J. Torbet and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lots seven (7) and eight (8) Block seven (7) West Tulsa
Indian Territory according to recorded plat there.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Belle J. Torbet and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Belle J. Torbet that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John O. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Belle J. Torbet all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
