WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we C. P. Alexander and Mary C. Alexander,
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.) DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Charles E. Stewart, receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged and confessed, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Charles E. Stewart and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
all of Lot Number Six (6) in Block number two (2) in the
Gridley Addition to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory,
according to the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Charles E. Stewart and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S. with said Charles E. Stewart that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary C. Alexander wife of the said C. P. Alexander for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Charles E. Stewart my all rights of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
