WARRANTY DEED
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John O Mitchell and Alice M Mitchell
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred seventy (\$170.00) DOLLARS,
money of which is hereby acknowledged by the grantor,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Jacob Moran, Tulsa, Indian Territory and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lots five (5) and six (6) Block seven (7) West Tulsa Creek Nation
Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Jacob Moran and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging
And hereby covenant with said Jacob Moran that they will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M Mitchell, wife of the said John O Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Jacob Moran my all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
