OFFICIAL FORMWARRANTY DEED  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we *C. B. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe* and *E. J. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe* their wives  
do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said *Robt. F. Miller* and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the  *Creek Nation* Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
*lots twenty three & twenty four (23 & 24) Black Eagle (B) Lynch*  
*& Forsythe's addition to Tulsa, Ind. Ter.*

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said *Robt. F. Miller* and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *Robt. F. Miller* that *they* will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. *It being agreed by Robt. F. Miller in the acceptance of this deed that there is to be no drilling for oil or gas on above lots*

And *E. J. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe* wife of the said *C. B. Lynch and Jennie Forsythe* for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *Robt. F. Miller* all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
