KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we F. W. Corlett and Minnie E. Corlett
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of thirteen hundred and fifty DOLLARS,
in hand paid by J. M. Reed, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged and confessed. do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said J. M. Reed and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The north half of Lot four (4) Block twelve (12)
Lindsey Second Addition to the City of Tulsa
Oklahoma according to the recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. M. Reed and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. M. Reed that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And Minnie E. Corlett wife of the said F. W. Corlett for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. M. Reed all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
