do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Ella Hardy and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the 7/8 of the NW 1/4 of the West half of Sec 18 of Twp 14 N. R. 12 E. of Dec 8, T. 19 N.  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot 27 No twenty seven Block 2 W. Two in Valley A.T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Ella Hardy and unto her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ella Hardy that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said S.H. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ella Hardy all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
