WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell, his wife
and W. B. Moore and Anna E. Moore
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty \$00 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by J. W. Lenson, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. W. Lenson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Moore Addition to West Tulsa, Creek Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lots Numbered Two (2) and six
(6) in Block Number (3), situated in Moore Addition
to West Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory,
according to plat filed thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said J. W. Lenson and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. W. Lenson that we will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John O. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. W. Lenson all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
