**WARRANTY DEED**  
WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred <sup>200.00</sup> DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid by W. C. Mundt the receipt of  
which is hereby acknowledged - do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said W. C. Mundt and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Town of West Tulsa Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lots numbered twenty-one (21) and  
twenty-two (22) in Block number eleven (11) in west  
Tulsa Creek nation Indian Territory according  
to the recorded plat filed thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said W. C. Mundt and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. C. Mundt that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell wife of the said John O. Mitchell for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. C. Mundt all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
