KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Thomas F. M. Laughlin single and
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred thirty DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said B. L. Conway and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot seven (7) in block nine (9) as shown by the official plat of the
said City

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said B. L. Conway and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant I with said B. L. Conway that I will forever warrant and de-
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Thomas F. M. Laughlin, wife of the said single for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
