# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

COMPARED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Mrs. M. E. Rogers and Myron C. Rogers, her husband  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (400.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said B. L. Conway and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot six (6) in Block eight (8) in the Owen addition to the City of Tulsa, Ind. Terr.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said B. L. Conway and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said B. L. Conway that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Myron C. Rogers, husband, wife of the said Mrs. M. E. Rogers for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said B. L. Conway my entire right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
