# WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we John O. Mitchell and Allice M. Mitchell his wife  
and W. P. Moore and Anna E. Moore his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred fifty — 150.00 DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid by L. R. Darrow the receipt of which is  
hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said L. R. Darrow and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the moore addition to West Tulsa creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lots numbered seventeen (17) and eighteen (18)  
in Block number three (3) situate in moore addition  
to West Tulsa creek nation Indian Territory, according  
to the recorded plat filed therefor

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said L. R. Darrow and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said L. R. Darrow that we will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Allice M. Mitchell, wife of the said John O. Mitchell and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said L. R. Darrow all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
