WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we J. L. Smiley and Alice R. Smiley his wife  
and J. E. Smiley and Sara Smiley  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and seventy five (575.00) DOLLARS,  
on hand paid by Robert B. Williamson the receipt of which  
we hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Robert B. Williamson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the River View Addition to the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lot (2) two on Block 6) six according to the recorded  
plat of River View Addition to the City of Tulsa Indian  
Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Robert B. Williamson and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Robert B. Williamson that they will forever warrant and de-  
fend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice R. Smiley, wife of the said J. L. Smiley and Sara Smiley wife of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Robert B. Williamson all right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
